PRACTICE PEARLS



To Torque or Not to Torque

When restoring dental implants, it is important to remember that every implant system is different, and has its own manufacturing recommendations and limits. Make sure that you know the screw torque limit for the system that you are using every time. It takes much less time to look up the systems specifications than to work on it with a screw retrieval kit. The difference of 5-10 Ncm can be catastrophic in some cases.


